Ira M. Calkins,
Ira Mann Calkins died at his home near the stone quarry, two miles south of this village, Saturday evening Feb. 21st, 1885. Mr. Calkins was born in the town of Painted Post, now Corning, Feb. 1st, 1804, and was the last member of the family of Frederick and Polly Calkins.— At an early age he came to this village and clerked for a short time in the store of the late Reuben Robie. In 1831 he married Harriet, fourth daughter of the late Col. John Whiting, of Bath, and for two years they resided in Pulteney.

They then removed to this town and have lived at or near their present residence since. He was an influential member of the Methodist church and for many years served on its official board until incapacitated by old age. Mr. Calkins was a man of remarkable vigor, and few persons probably done more hard work than he. In Sept. 1879 his eyesight began to dim and he gradually became blind, but he endured his trials with remarkable Christian fortitude and patience.

Dec. 20th, 1881, Mr. and Mrs. Calkins celebrated their golden wedding which was largely attended by relatives and friends.

Mr. Calkins was the father of twelve children, ten of whom reached maturity. The following are now living: John W. of Louisiana, Mo., Mary K., widow of J. B. Smalldge; Helen A., widow of the late Levi Robie, and Harriet E.; Emma, wife of P. M. Little; Ira F., of Rushford, N. Y.; and Jefferson W., all living in this town, except as above mentioned. Two died in infancy; Sarah died in 1860, Levi died in the service in 1862, and Mary, wife of T. G. Ford, died in Toledo, Ohio, in 1883.

Mrs. Calkins, who survives her husband, is now in her 75th year.

Mrs. Ford had always resided in Bath and vicinity until last March, when she removed with her family to Toledo, O. She was connected with the Centenary Methodist Episcopal Church and its Sunday school in this village from early childhood, and in every position, as a scholar and teacher in the Sunday school as well as a member of the church, she was always faithful, amiable, kind and Christian in her bearing towards those associated with her. She was a faithful wife, a devoted mother, an affectionate child and a true friend. Mrs. Ford was greatly esteemed by all who knew her and had the pleasure of her acquaintance. Her death has caused sadness and gloom in many hearts, but they mourn not without hope, for her faith and trust in Christ the Savior, illustrated by a holy life, was such as to afford the fullest evidence of her preparation for the great change. For her to die was gain. "She has gone on before," as said her aged and venerable father in the church service the Sabbath after her death. While Brother Ford and friends were at the burial service of Mrs. Ford, their youngest son, Sherman, passed from earth to the heavenly home, and mother and son were again reunited never to be separated. "Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord."

(CALKINS—Ira Mann Calkins was born in Corning, N. Y., Feb. 1, 1804, and died at his home near Bath, N. Y., Feb. 21, 1885. He married Miss Harriet White, of Bath, Dec. 20, 1831, and in April following removed to the town of Pulteney, Steuben county. About two years later he returned and settled in the vicinity of Bath, not far from the site of his last farm. During the year 1834 he became the subject of a deep conviction of sin and was converted at a meeting held in the barn of Moses Dudley, about a mile and a half north of Bath. He united at once with a Methodist class, came in due time into full membership, and has remained through more than fifty years a faithful and acceptable member. He was a man of great piety and of great moral worth, and his life was a constant example to all who knew him. He was a member of the Christian Physical Society. He was sustained by Christian brethren as a gradual falling of all his hopes and tears in peace. His wife, with seven of their twelve children, twenty-five grandchildren and four great-grandchildren, were all present at the funeral. He was buried in the cemetery at Bath on the 23rd inst.
